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## **Finance Committee**

Minutes of Meeting July 21st, 2021 at 9 pm -Bill Platt Training Center Due to the COVID 19 threat and Shelter in Place order, this meeting was held by teleconference (via audio participation).

- 1. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 9 am PM by FC Director Michael Tilles. Also present: FC Treasurer Naomi Schwartz and FC Director Geoffrey Beaty. Also attending District Administrator David Crowl, Captain Chris Ottolini, Executive Assistant & Bookkeeper Robin Dills.
- **2. Agenda Approval:** Director Beaty moved to adopt the agenda as written, seconded by Treasurer Schwartz. All ayes.
- **3. Meeting Minutes Approval:** Treasurer Schwartz moved to approve the June 16th, 2021 FC meeting minutes and was seconded by Director Beaty with agreed amendments. All ayes.
- **4. Privilege of the floor:** None.
- **5. Ambulance Revenue- Wittman:** Net Payments are up about 12K from our average of ~65K. CLSD is seeing an influx of calls this summer than previous due to COVID and lifting of restrictions.
  - a. Payments for June 2021 totaled \$78,282 with A/R of \$541,835. June had 74 billable incidents with 45 transports. Cumulative are 733 billable incidents with 542 transports f.
  - b. <u>June Ambulance runs:</u> CLSD has seen a significant increase in COVID transports with COVID positive patients (6 within a week & a half). ER's (in the Santa Rosa area) are overwhelmed with COVID patients. Even with being a higher vaccinated area (within some demographics) CLSD has seen more cases than the last wave in January. The Delta variant of the virus is here within the community.
  - c. <u>GEMT QAF</u> income is being recognized (as write-downs) through the Medicare and Medical discounts. See CLSD YTD Report.
  - d. <u>Revenue:</u> Net payments are ~\$741k for the FY21. This is about a 20% increase from FY20.
  - e. <u>Parcel Taxes:</u> Historically, CLSD receives a final payment for FY21 in July and Aug for Sonoma and Mendocino County. CLSD can expect to see ~35k deposited in July from Sonoma.
- **6. Expenses YTD:** Expenses are showing to be slightly higher than budgeted, but within a reasonable range. Payroll increased as CLSD shifted from the Prior DA retiring and the New DA beginning. CLSD had more Medical Supply purchases due to COVID. Some expenses were put on hold (ex: rebranding). Please see the footnotes on the P&L for more details.
- 7. Cash Flow: a positive Cash flow (in respect to the budget) is being recognized but down ~\$80K from last year to date. Charles Schwab investment is not gaining as expected. DA Crowl has made the decision to keep the \$200k in the Exchange Bank account at this time.

- **8. Banking and Investments Statement review**: The Financial statements and check register were reviewed. Questions were answered to provide clarification as needed.
- **9. Ambulance Transport data** 45 Transport and 74 Billable Incidents. See reports in the agenda packet or #5 (a). above.

### 10. Other:

## a. Crews are doing a fantastic job:

- CLSD Crews are being very diligent about using personal protective equipment and decontaminating the ambulances after each call.
- Also, to support RCMS (nursing staff shortage), CLSD Paramedics and EMT's now are working in the clinic.
- It has been a very busy month. 31 hours were uncovered after the 3<sup>rd</sup> out ambulance was deployed (understaffed). Ran 2 – 3<sup>rd</sup> out Ambulances with the assistance of Captain Golly and DA Crowl.
- b. Review of Aging: Treasurer Schwartz has requested the number of payment plans currently on our accounts. Bookkeeper Frost will be gathering that information to update Treasurer Schwartz. The aging has increased about 60K from last year. CLSD is in the same range compared to other comparable districts. All claims will continue to be reviewed and assigned the appropriate action based on the policy
- c. <u>Refunds:</u> Treasurer Schwartz has requested more information regarding the refunds located (column H) on the CLSD Ambulance Revenue Report. Bookkeeper Robin Dills has requested the information from Wittman and will pass it along to Treasurer Schwartz.
- d. <u>Meeting with CPA:</u> Its that time of the year again to request the services and oversight to closes the books for FY21. CPA Craig Collins has agreed to provide those services again this year to CLSD. DA Crowl has asked for a meeting with CPA Collins to discuss the accounting of Ambulance Revenue (currently accrual method) verses on a cash type bases (time and date TBD).
- e. <u>GEMT OAF:</u> Director Beaty has requested some updated information on the GEMT QAF program. QE: It was first expected (and budgeted last FY20) that the funds would be received separately (as its own revenue stream). When did the change to the program occur and did Wittman receive notice of this? DA Crowl and Bookkeeper Dills will research and update the FC committee.
- f. Training Grant: Funded Sep 2020 through Aug 2021. Within Budget (~\$200K)
- g. **Shout Out**: FC Director Michael Tilles expresses his appreciation for being invited to share lunch and get to know the Crew at CLSD.

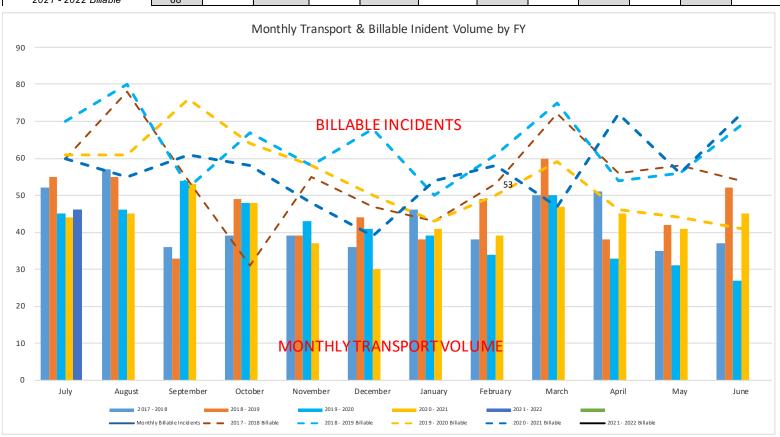
