Finance Committee

Minutes of Meeting Nov. 16th, 2022, at 9:00 am - Bill Platt Training Center

This meeting conducted by teleconference and in person.

- 1. Call to Order: The meeting called to order at 9:00 am by Treasurer Michael Tilles. Also present: Director Naomi Schwartz, Director Beaty, DA David Crowl, Captain Chris Ottolini, and Bookkeeper Robin Dills.
- **2. Agenda Approval:** Director Beaty moved to adopt the agenda, seconded by Director Schwartz. All ayes.
- **3. Meeting Minutes Approval:** Director Beaty moved to approve the Nov 16th, 2022; Director Schwartz seconded meeting minutes. All ayes.
- 4. Privilege of the floor: none
- 5. Old Business
 - a. Cal Pers 2022 Audit Recommendation
 - The annual Cal Pers audit was conducted in September and October 2022. The audit pertained to holiday pay. CLSD was found to be in compliance of Cal Pers practices with regards to holiday pay, documentation and reporting. However, a recommendation was made to review CLSD holiday pay practices and formalize in the policy and procedure manual. CLSD holiday pay was summarized as a holiday bonus program where shift employees get paid a bonus for working the holiday. Director Schwartz expressed concern if this was normal practice in State of California. DA Crowl stated that accepted practice is traditional time and half for holiday pay. Director Beaty recommended that this issue be brought to the full BOD at the November meeting.
- **6. Ambulance Revenue** Net payments for Sept 2022 totaled \$61,093 with A/R of \$343,710 which was over \$200,000 less than last year at this time.
- 7. Expenses YTD: Reviewed and found to be wrong numbers in the Ambulance Revenue section. P&L was rejected as written and will be corrected for BOD meeting in November.
- 8. Cash Flow: Reviewed.
- 9. Banking review: Reviewed

10. Ambulance Transport data October 52 billable incidents with 34 transports. CLSD's ambulance revenue is above the anticipated monthly average of \$65K coming in at ~\$70k in October. District had ~16 hrs. uncovered with 0 calls missed.

11. Other:

- UC RFP update: Discussed that one statement of interest was received.
 Moving forward with timeline. Proposal submission deadline is December 30, 2022.
- Director Schwartz questioned if there was a need for CLSD to form an Executive Committee. Director Schwartz stated that the Executive Committee would be comprised of the President, Secretary and Treasurer of CLSD. Director Tilles was hesitant to bring to BOD meeting due to possible "resentment of powers" that the finance committee currently holds. Director Beaty said it does make sense to have such a committee but that it works well as is and is reluctant to fix something that is not broken. Director Tilles stated he did not think such a committee is needed at this time. Director Schwartz stated she was glad to have the discussion and would table the idea until a clear need was presented.

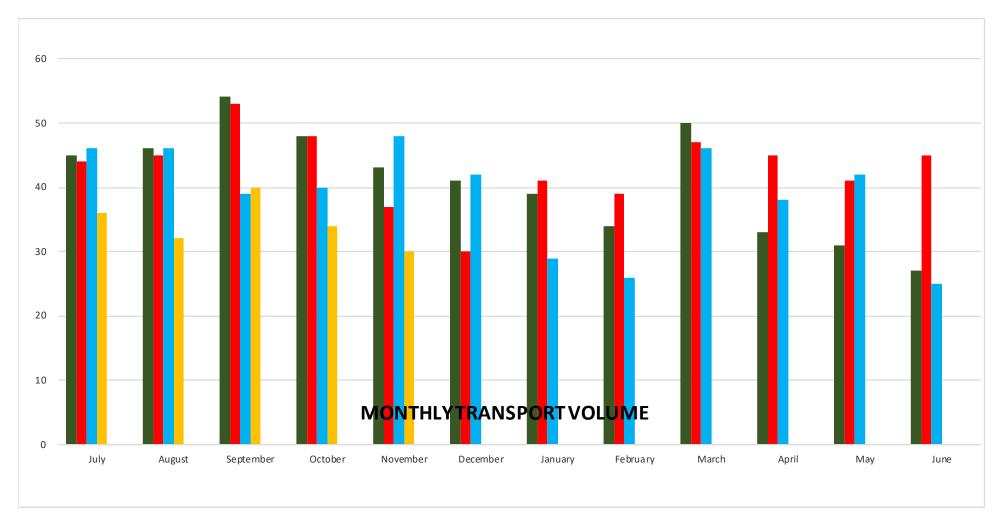

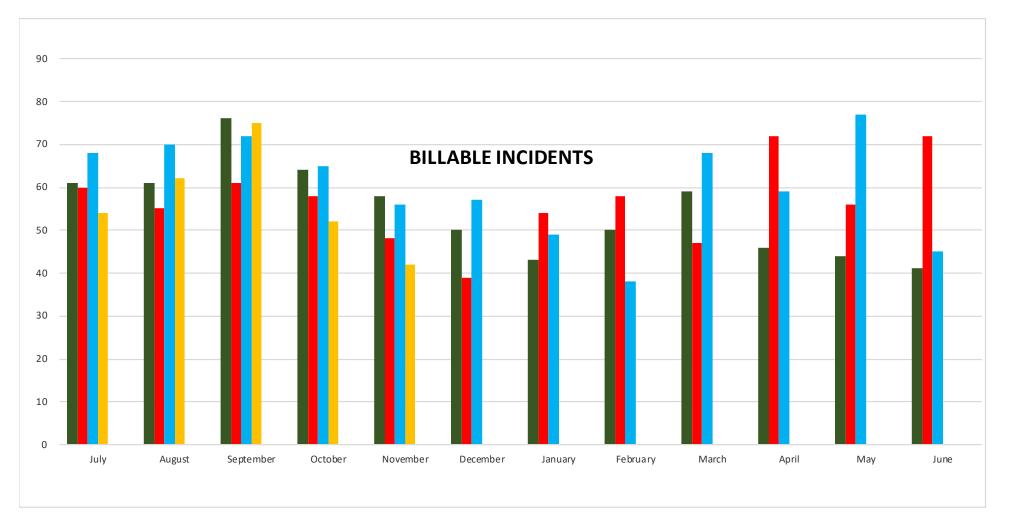
