## BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING MINUTES July 22, 2024

Meeting called to order at 4:00 PM

After review, the Meeting Agenda was unanimously approved. (CA/LT)

After review, the minutes of the June 24, 2024 BOD meeting were amended to show the <u>loss</u> in FY24 for RCMS/UC was currently \$589,087 Item 1 New Business. (MT/CC)

#### 1. Presentations:

a. Katrina Bartolomie who is the Mendocino County Recorder, County Clerk, County Assessor and in charge of all county elections presented an overview of how CLSD can best take care of its duties in terms of elections and the filling of vacancies to the CLSD BOD.

She clarified that every term is a new term and will as such require filing of specific forms with Mendocino County (see below). She detailed that Michael Tilles, Carolyn Andre, Geoff Beaty and Leslie Tittle would have until 8/9/24 to file their papers with Sonoma County.

The forms to be completed with the appropriate county are:

Declaration of Candidacy ...must be done in person

Form 700 Statement of Economic Interest...again

Form 470 partially completed if not accepting campaign contributions and totally completed if accepting contributions.

Statement of Qualifications for the November ballot. This is optional and involves an additional payment. The candidate is listed on the on the ballot with added information for the voter to read.

The next election is November 5, 2024

She administered the oath of office to Naomi Schwartz and Cathleen Crosby.

b. DA Crowl presented the speech that Marcella Williams presented at the June 2024 CREST meeting to over 60 EMS participants. This was in reference to an incident that occurred over Memorial Day weekend. Mrs. Williams' husband Ian survived a cardiac arrest of over 25 minutes with the assistance of REDCOM, CalFire, CLSD, NSCF and SCVFD. To quote Mrs. Williams, "I know what collaboration and teamwork looks like when it is working."

#### 2. Old Business

(MT/NS approved)

a. CLSD Quick Response Vehicle purchase: DA Crowl presented the recommendation from BOD Finance Committee to purchase a Quick Response Vehicle for \$14,500, \$52 a month insurance cost, approximately \$2000 branding cost. This vehicle is currently owned by SCVFD. SCVFD is offering to sell it to CLSD including all the lights/sirens and radios which are worth approximately \$8,000.

b. CLSD By Laws were presented. It was decided to postpone the discussion until the August 2024 BOD meeting.

#### 3. Reports

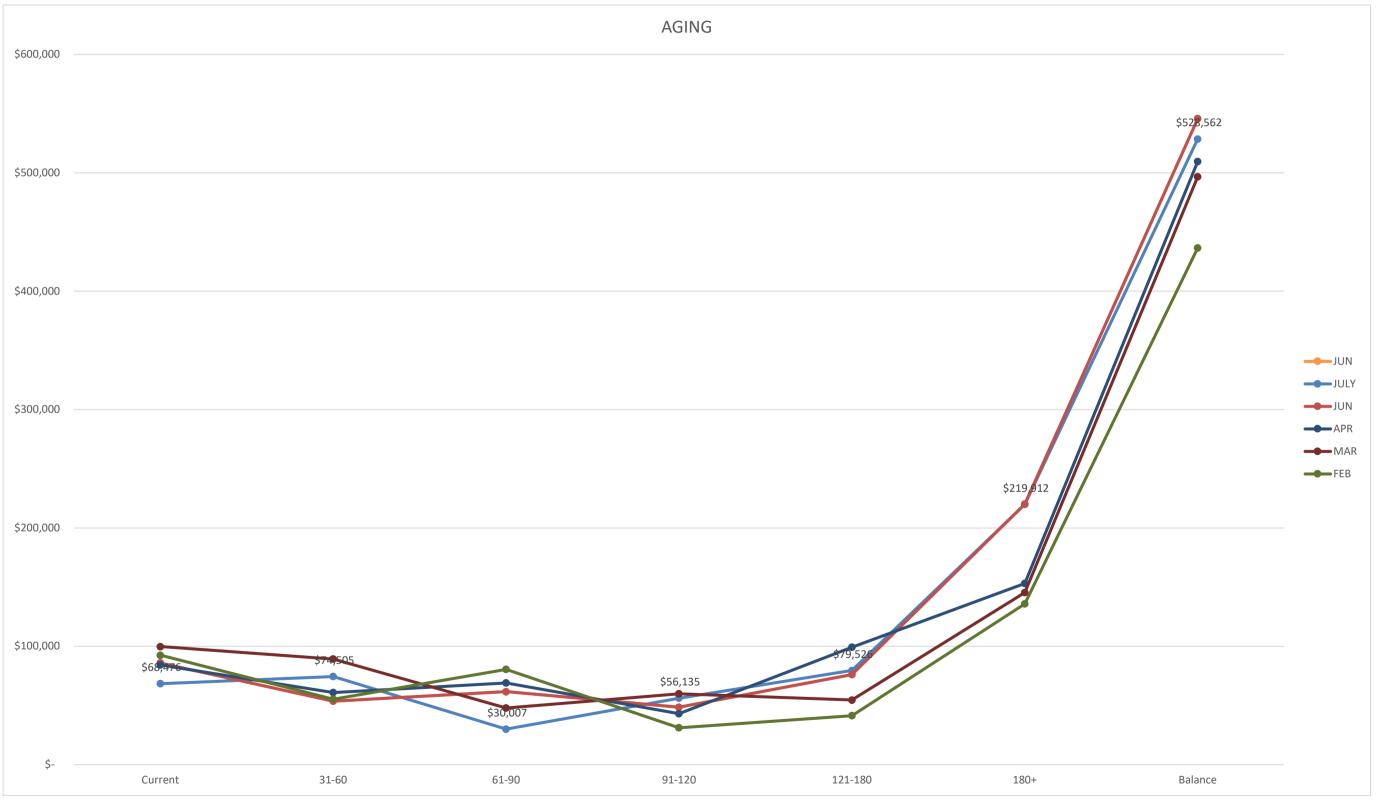
- a. DA Crowl reported on the new ambulance purchase. It needs branding and radio installation. It is expected that this will be completed in August 2024.
- b. OM Golly is away in Minneapolis at an Image Trend conference. Image Trend is the electronic patient care reporting program that CLSD utilizes.
- b. DA Crowl reported that 3 CLSD EMTs have enrolled in Napa Valley College paramedic program which will require them being there every Thursday and Friday until completion of the course.
- b. DA Crowl presented Ambulance Revenue Report. It was noted that Ambulance Revenue was down approximately \$100,000 from 2023. The FY24 Profit & Loss Budget Overview was presented with discussion about accrual vs. cash budgeting. It was noted that the budget July 2023 through June 2024 was basically a break-even budget for the year. CLSD Run Data Report, Monthly Ambulance Data were presented and found acceptable.

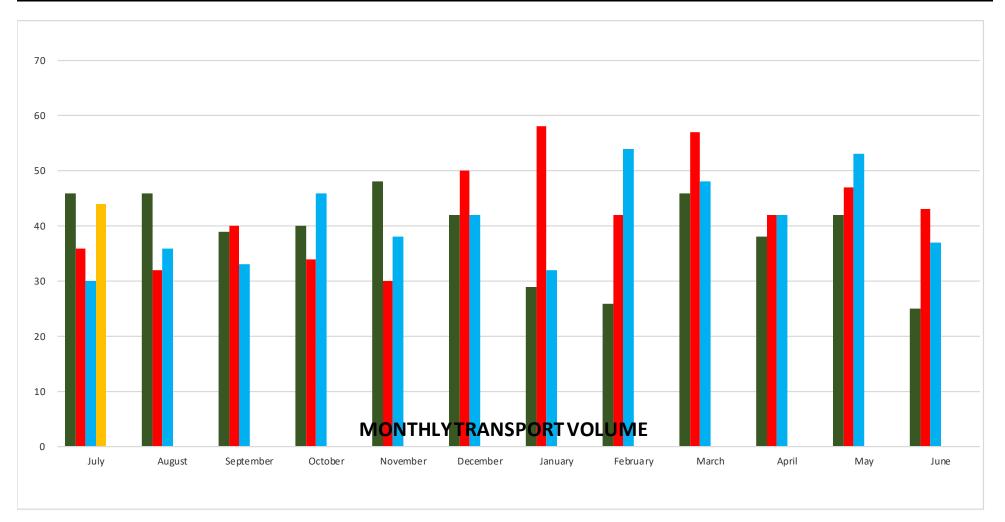

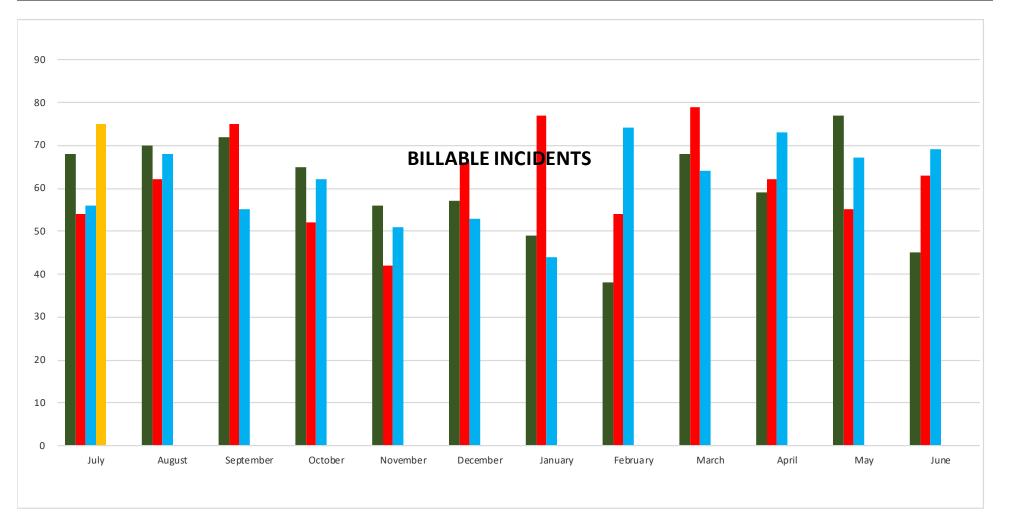
