# BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING MINUTES Monday, August 26, 2024

Meeting called to order at 4:01 by BOD President, Geoff Beaty

After review, the Meeting Agenda was unanimously approved.

After review, the minutes of the July 22, 2024 BOD meeting were unanimously approved.

### 1. Old Business:

- **a. CLSD Open House** Leslie Tittle announced that the Open House will be held on Saturday, October 26, 2024 from 2 to 4 PM. There was discussion about how to get more people to attend. There will be a meeting to go over the logistics.
- **b. CLSD By Laws** The amended by laws were unanimously adopted with the agreed upon changes. There was discussion about further changes that may be forthcoming.

#### 2. New Business:

a. Director's Oaths of Office The Secretary of the BOD administered the oaths of office to Directors Tittle, Beaty for full terms and Director Tilles for a short term. There was brief discussion about Director Andre who did not file her paperwork by August 9, 2024 to run for re-election to the BOD. This will open up the nomination process for someone to be appointed to the BOD. DA Crowl and President Beaty will determine when and how to proceed with this.

### 3. Reports

- a. Insurance Review Director Tilles presented the information received from CLSD insurance agent, Kim Maneiro of Cindy Elbert Insurance at the CLSD Finance Committee meeting on 8/22/24. He stated that more information was needed on whether the building was properly insured, whether there was adequate coverage for losses due to fire/earthquake and whether the ambulances should be covered for replacement value or their agreed upon value (which is how they are currently insured). Director Beaty suggested contacting legal representation that is skilled in this information. Director Schwartz suggested contacting someone whose job it was to scrutinize insurance policies for clients. She will contact such a person a come back to the BOD with his contact information and then a further decision of which manner to proceed with the CLSD insurance analysis will be decided.
- **b. REDCOM** DA Crowl reviewed with the BOD how REDCOM works and how CLSD uses it in Sonoma County. Note: Howard Forest is the dispatch service provider for Mendocino County. Currently, AMR has been running REDCOM with 33 employees

for three shifts a day...24/7. AMR has given notice that they will no longer be

staffing REDCOM. It was decided at the REDCOM meeting that the newly formed REDCOM will be a stand-alone government agency for Sonoma County with its own BOD. This will be comprised of 3 fire officials, 1 ambulance company (which is CLSD), 2 members for Coastal Valley EMS and 1 member from the city of Santa Rosa. Currently, CLSD pays \$32,000 annually for REDCOM services.

### c. Finance YTD

DA Crowl presented the Ambulance Revenue Report, CLSD Run Data Report, Monthly Ambulance Data which were found acceptable. There was no FY24 Profit & Loss Budget overview due to an administrative problem with payroll. OM Golly was complimented for her comprehensive Ambulance Run Data report.

### 4. Shout outs

DA Crowl received a shout out for his extensive work with REDCOM where he serves on their BOD.

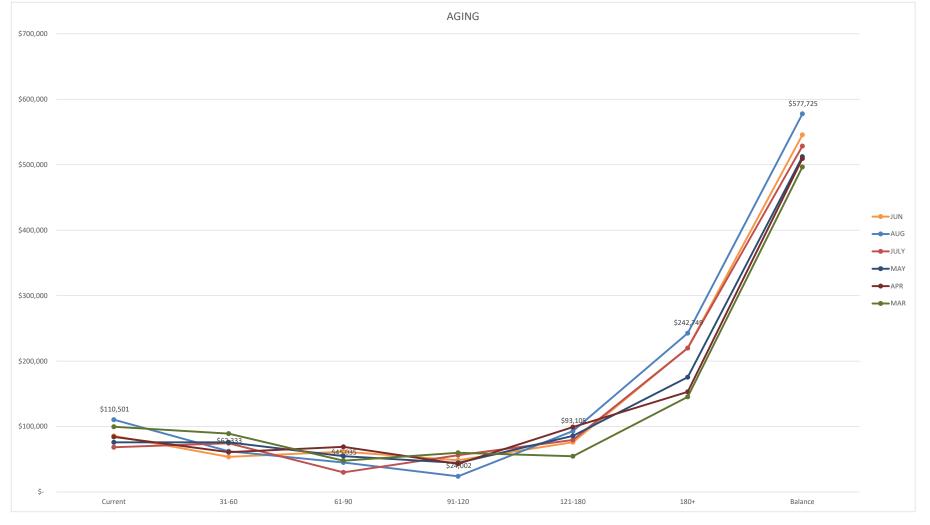

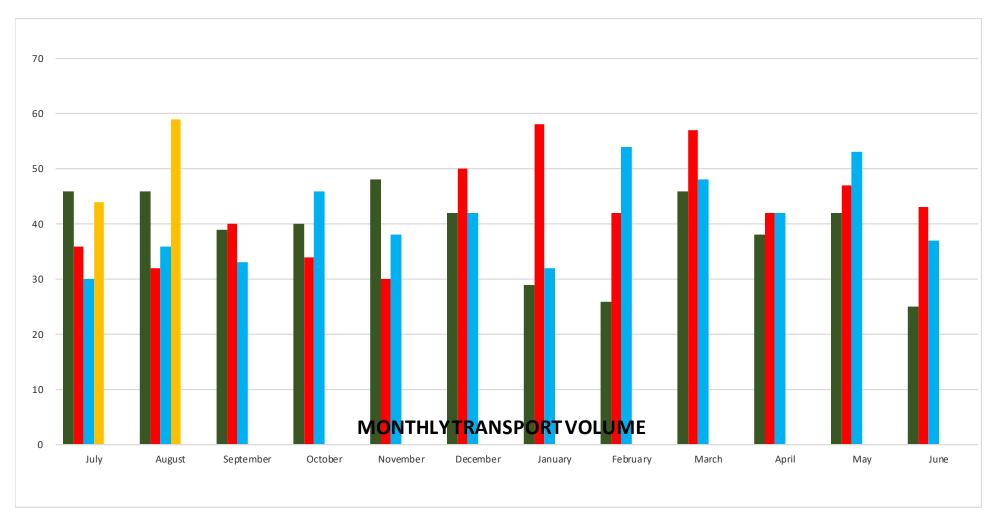

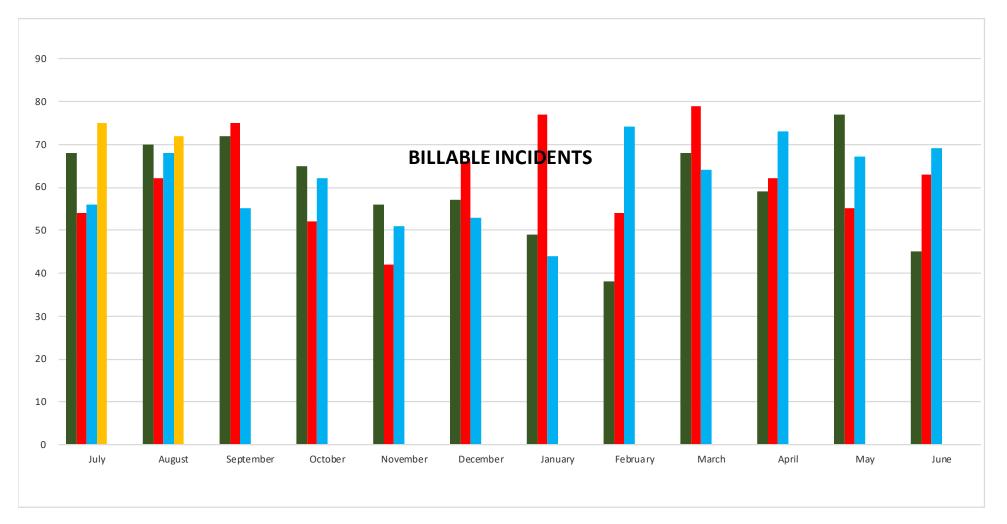
